Statement of Compliance on Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2011 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (recast)

API Weinschel products are classified as Industrial Monitoring and Control Equipment, which is excluded from the scope of the RoHS Directive until July 2017. However, API Weinschel, Inc. has undertaken a program of evaluating materials and processes to achieve RoHS compliance while maintaining our performance and quality standards. The products listed below are currently produced and sold under this exclusion; however, they are fully compliant (subject to exemptions listed below) as of the date above.

RoHS compliance of products may be by exemption as stated in the Directive's annex III:

- 6(a): Lead as an alloying element in steel for machining purposes and in galvanised steel containing up to 0,35 % lead by weight
- 6(b): Lead as an alloying element in aluminium containing up to 0,4 % lead by weight
- 6(c): Copper alloy containing up to 4 % lead by weight
- 7(c)-I: Electrical and electronic components containing lead in a glass or ceramic other than dielectric ceramic in capacitors, e.g. piezoelectronic devices, or in a glass or ceramic matrix compound
- 8(b): Cadmium and its compounds in electrical contacts
